Candidates who are unable to undertake the unit during their first semester of enrolment must defer commencement of their course until they are able to attend this unit. Health Law candidates are encouraged to undertake LAWS6881 <i>Introduction to Law for Health Professionals</i> in lieu of LAWS6252 <i>Legal Reasoning and the Common Law System</i> if available. ³ Candidates enrolling in units from the Master of Taxation must complete (i) LAWS6825 <i>The Impact of Tax on Business Structures & Operations</i> and/or any other pre-requisite unit or units specified by the Faculty. The MBL Program Coordinator (in conjunction with the MTax Program Coordinator) may waive this requirement in appropriate cases. (ii) Candidates who do not have a qualification in accountancy, or who have not completed a legal studies unit as part of a degree in business or commerce within a common law jurisdiction will be required to complete LAWS6252 <i>Legal Reasoning and the Common Law System</i>. The MBL Program Coordinator may waive this requirement in appropriate cases. ⁴ To be completed by candidates who do not hold a qualification in law (LLB/DiplLaw or equivalent). ⁵ This unit must be undertaken during the first semester of enrolment. Candidates who have previously completed study in International Law may be exempt from undertaking this unit. ⁶ Candidates may undertake any postgraduate unit offered by the Faculty unless specified otherwise. ⁷ Unless and until otherwise approved by the Program Coordinator, all candidates except candidates enrolling in LAWS6039 <i>Discrimination in the Workplace</i>, LAWS6130 <i>Dispute Resolution in Australia</i> and LAWS6821 <i>Mediation – Skills and Theory</i> must first complete LAWS6071 <i>Labour Law</i> before enrolling in any other labour law units of study, provided that full-time candidates may enrol in other labour law units of study concurrently with this unit of study. ⁸ The Jurisprudence Research Project (12cp) is to be undertaken during the final semester(s) of candidature. A fully developed proposal outline (approximately 1,000 words) must be submitted to the Program Coordinator for approval prior to enrolment. ⁹ Candidates who commenced the MLLR prior to January 2010 must complete the compulsory unit WORK6018 <i>International Industrial Relations</i> or equivalent (formerly named: IREL5001 <i>Australia Industrial Relations</i>, WORK5001 <i>Introduction to Employment Relations</i>, WORK6000 <i>Employment Relations</i>). Candidates commencing the MLLR after January 2010 are required to complete the compulsory unit WORK6017 <i>Human Resource Strategies</i>.</p>
