- A maximum of 48 credit points (and no more than 24 credit points per semester) can be undertaken as non-award study.
- Non-award study is not applicable for units which have quota restrictions including: External Placement Program; Social Justice Clinical Course; Sydney Law Review and Jessup International Law Moot. *Please note: other units may also be restricted at the time of application.*
